

General Prohibitions (15 CFR, Part 736)

You cannot:

1. Export or re-export, without a license or license exception, to another country a US origin item if its reasons for control shown in its ECCN are also reasons for control to the country of destination
2. Export or re-export from abroad, without a license or license exception, foreign made items containing more than a de minimis amount of controlled content if its reasons for control shown in its ECCN are also reasons for control to the country of destination
3. Export or re-export from abroad, without a license or license exception, foreign made items made from controlled (ECCN) US technology or software
4. Engage in actions prohibited by a denial order
 - Denied persons
5. Export or re-export to prohibited end users or end uses
 - Nuclear proliferation, missile technology, chemical/biological weapons
6. Export or re-export to embargoed destinations
 - Cuba, Iran, Sudan
7. Support proliferation activities
 - Financing, freight forwarding, Servicing, Employment
8. Transit a certain foreign countries
 - Albania, Armenia, Azerbaijan, Belarus, Cambodia, Cuba, Georgia, Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan, Laos, Mongolia, North Korea, Russia, Tajikistan, Turkmenistan, Ukraine, Uzbekistan, Vietnam
9. Violate terms or conditions of a license, license exception, or order
10. Proceed with a transaction with knowledge that a violation has occurred or is about to occur
